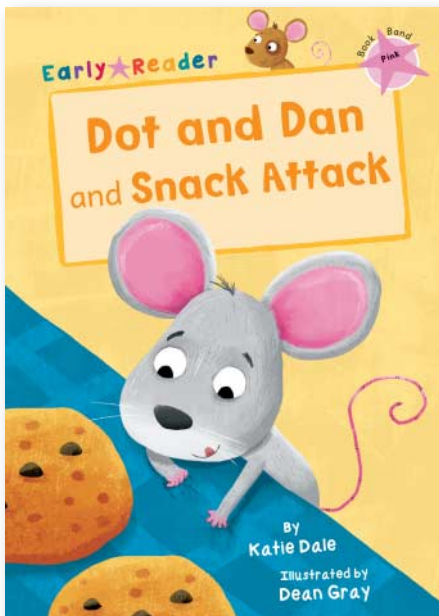


Maverick Activity Pack
