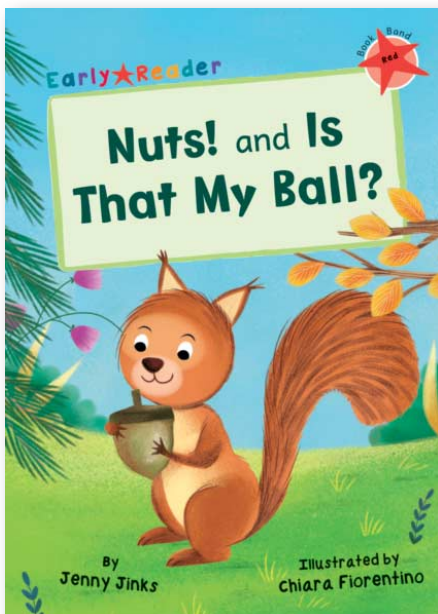


Maverick Activity Pack

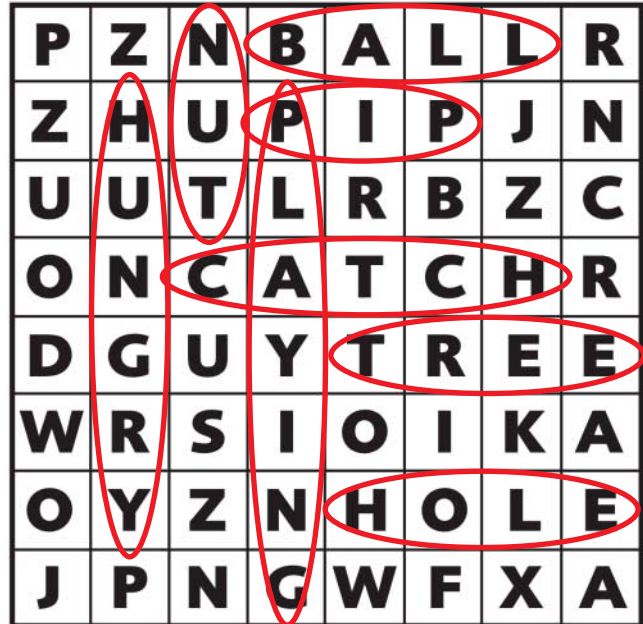
