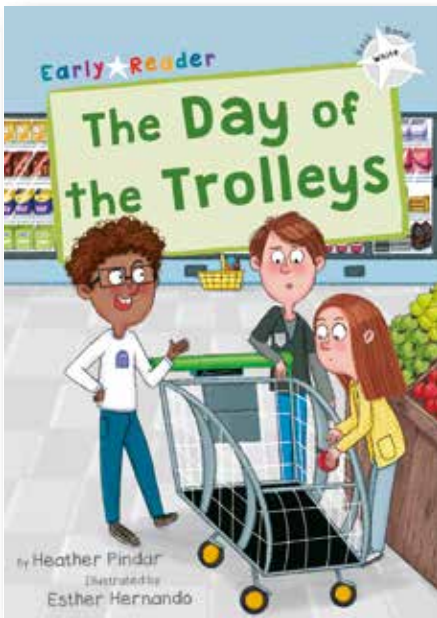


Maverick Activity Pack

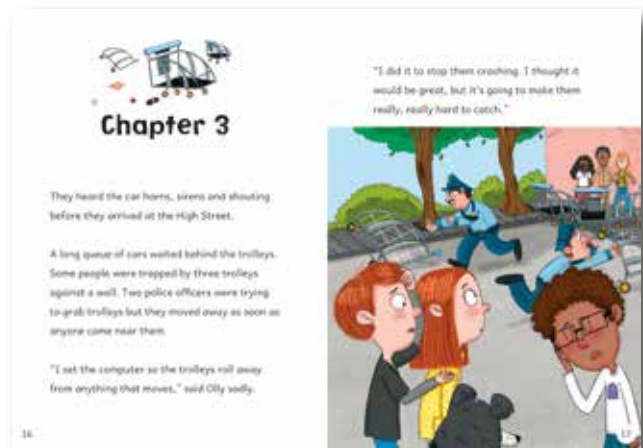
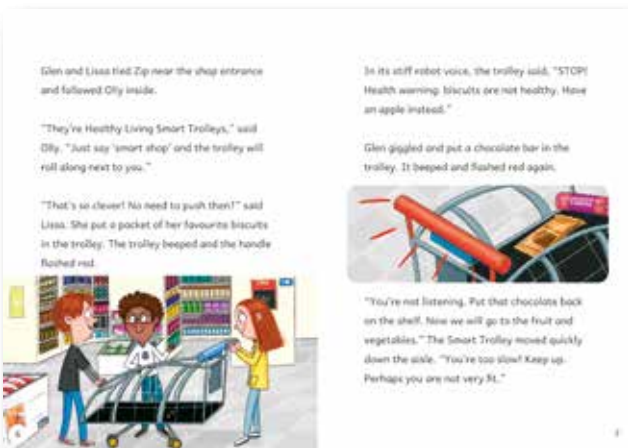
